Intended Audience: Adults

Workshop Title: "Understanding the Bully"
Presentation Snapshot: This bullying workshop provides teachers, administrators, and parents with vital information that will help recognize the many faces of bullying. Participants will develop a deeper awareness of bullying and learn skills to address and decrease problem behaviors.

Additional Workshop Details

The participants will learn what makes bullies, bully. This insight provides tools for both parents and educators to help solve difficult situations. The curriculum helps to decrease the occurrence of new bullying behaviors.

Intended Audience: Adults & Children

Workshop Title: "Tolerance Makes the World Go 'Round"
Presentation Snapshot: This workshop shows how stereotypical beliefs are passed down from one generation to the next and that these beliefs can cause

preconceived ideas about others. Children bully as a way to say "your not with me" to assert themselves socially. This is a result of beliefs.

Additional Workshop Details

Description for Adults: Participants will discuss the importance of respecting each others differences in order to form a more tolerant atmosphere for themselves and any children that may be involved in their lives.

Description for Children: Participants will evaluate how learned behavior passed on from friends and family can lead to biased opinions of others without reason. Participants will be challenged to shed stereotypical thoughts about others in order to form a more tolerant atmosphere that is accepting to all people.

• Workshop Title: "Conflict Resolution"

Presentation Snapshot: Develop positive and effective conflict resolution techniques that will assist you in making better choices in every aspect of your life. You will learn cooperation, appreciation of diversity, communication, conflict resolution, and avoidance skills to empower yourself!

Additional Workshop Details

Description for Adults: Participants will evaluate their coping skills and conflict styles while examining self-destructive behavior patterns. Adults will learn cooperation, appreciation of diversity, communication, conflict resolution, and avoidance skills.

Description for Children: This workshop helps participants to develop positive and effective conflict resolution techniques that will assist them in making good decisions and avoid the consequences of bad decisions. Participants will identify and understand conflict and learn techniques for improving conflict resolution and communication skills.

Intended Audience: Children & Youth

Workshop Title: "Living Bully Free and Loving Me"
Presentation Snapshot: The Evolve Project performers may engage, entertain and excite the audience. Children and youth will learn the definition of tolerance and positive self-esteem. Mastering these tools together increases participant success and raises awareness of bullying in school and online.

Additional Workshop Details

Our presentation entertains and provides skills where participants will learn about bullying, its affects and consequences. Additional Workshop Details

The curriculum focuses on working with small groups of children who require additional focus on anti-bullying techniques. Children will work in teams to gain an understanding of the consequences of bullying behaviors and how they affect peers, family and their community.

• Workshop Title: "Positive Self Esteem and Loving Me"

Presentation Snapshot: Are you a bully? This workshop helps children and youth develop a picture of how they view themselves and its role in all aspects of their lives! This can also be utilized as a follow up to the "Living Bully Free and Loving Me!" Empower the movement.

Additional Workshop Details

Participants will discuss responsibilities they have to build and establish a positive view daily. This dynamic curriculum provides structured activities which engage, educate and empower youth to recognize their own personal power!

Workshop Title: "Building Positive Peer Relationships"
